We had to pay for freight, and that cost has been factored into our selling price and rounded to the nearest \$0.25 increment. The wood was purchased in this manner because there have been no carving shows (our normal place to get wood) in the last couple of years due to the pandemic.

CHARLOTTE SHOWCASE OF WOODCARVING

All Triad Woodcarvers are encouraged to enter the Charlotte Woodcarvers Showcase of Woodcarving scheduled for the April 1-3 weekend. Download the show brochure and registration from their website and register. You can register online or by mail. Note that registrations after March 18 will incur an additional five dollar fee. Once registered, you will receive a registration number and use that to list your carving when you go to the show to enter on April 1 or very early on April 2.

Members of the Triad Woodcarvers Club have won tons of first place and bet of categories prizes, and we have won the Best of Novice for the past two shows. Triad Woodcarvers entered 417 carvings by 31 carvers at the last show.

This is the largest woodcarving show in the Southeast. They will have five free seminars by professional carvers, top carving supplies and knives, etc by the best in the business and good value as well. The seminars include carving a small bear, anatomy and structure of hands, clay modeling, and painting. Note that our STEM team led by Will Crawford will have an eight foot table for the Club highlighting our program of teaching woodcarving to high school students.

Also, John Dunkle will be at the showcase. Don't miss this opportunity to add to your selection of knives! He will also be offering a sharpening service.
